- The kids enjoyed a break from school during Easter. They joined me on a couple of day trips for my work. We have started reading The Voyage of the Dawn Treader together.
- Training events at our office have been helping people from many organizations to learn. In March we completed Project Management for Development training and many people passed the exam. This week we are learning about Truth Centered Transformation...replacing the lies of the world with God's truth.
- The staffing challenges we were facing have settled down
- This past Monday I was able to visit some villages and hear many encouraging stories from our work...how the churches are reaching out to bring about change in their communities. One church was instrumental in planting 7500 trees in their area.

Pray:

- I will be traveling away from the family a lot this month. Tomorrow I head North with a team of people to evaluate the church in community programs in that area.

Pray for protection as we travel many miles, including some bad roads

Pray especially for Beth and the kids who will stay in the city. Beth has been experiencing a lot of physical pain this week, which makes it difficult to do even basic things around the house.

- Pray that God will lead us to the right local church...we are still alternating between three.
- Pray that we will learn Chichewa quickly and well. It's going very slowly..
