November 4 Budget and Missions- Thank you for your continued, faithful giving towards our church budget. As of October 8 we are at a deficit of \$16800.00. Continue to keep our many missionaries in your daily prayers as they go out to preach the gospel.

November 11: Back to God Ministries International- Back to God Ministries International began more than 75 years ago with a three-fold mission:Proclaim that Jesus Christ is Lord, Help followers of Jesus grow in their faith and Strengthen the church.

November 18: John Moerman-Chaplaincy Care- John Moerman has been serving as Senior Volunteer Chaplain at the Chinook Regional Hospital for the past seventeen years. Shared funding by Lethbridge churches and individuals is necessary to continue this ministry.

November 25: World Renew/World Hunger-In communities where poverty is prevalent, men, women, and children often struggle to grow enough food, lack access to clean water, fight to rebuild after a disaster, and experience injustice. Together with World Renew we can equip those in need with the skills and knowledge required to move beyond these barriers.

Council Meeting Minutes October 22, 2018

Landen called the meeting to order. Stephan opened with devotions. Council and Search Committee met together for support/encourage/communicate. Thank you to search committee for their work. Meeting with search committee adjured. Council continued to meet for council meeting. Had discussions about the proposed Pastor Job Description. Thanks to executive for their work on this. With a few additions and adjustments made, the job description was approved and shared with Search Committee. Updated stewardship mandate was reviewed and approved. Discussion about church financials, review of 2018 financials. Approved by council. Review of 2019 budget and approved by council. This will go to the congregational meeting November 19 for approval. Evangelism requested additional funding for the Nigerian Scholarships. Brief descriptions of each missionary will be provided with the congregational meeting agenda so people are aware of who's supported. April will be stepping down as administrator for 2019. Thank you April for the work you did! Council will begin looking for a new administrator to replace her before 2019. Updated search committee mandate was reviewed and approved. The church profile from search committee was approved.

Approved motion to have building committee get quotes for potential future upgrades: handicapped bathroom upstairs, elevator replacement, acoustics in fellowship hall, paint exterior of church, repair sidewalk cracks, and paint/carpet the pastors office. Approval of potential names for additional members to the Evangelism committee. Pulpit supply is filling up for early 2019 and still looking at the possibility of an interim pastor coming in April or May. Discussion about Classis Overture. Motion that Classis Delegates from Iron Springs support the denominations' position on sexuality at the Oct 26/27 meeting. Hess & Helen Baarda have the opportunity to join World Renew's tour in 2019. Council approved \$1,500 to support their trip. Council will continue to get the addition of the Bridge App back onto the next classis agenda.

Church Administrator

April will be stepping down from Church administrator by December 15, 2018 so council is looking for interested applicants in the church administrator position. The desired candidate should have strong organizational abilities and be a self-starter with the ability to problem solve, delegate appropriately and act independently. Professional conduct and confidentiality are crucial and an expected part of this position. Computer skills, including efficient use of Microsoft Office are required for this position. Previous experience in an administrative setting would be an asset. The position is 8-10 hours a week for administrator tasks and 3-4 hours a month for clerk tasks. We are looking to fill the position as soon as possible for more information talk to Landen Stronks or Tracy Reurink.
