

#### May 5 - Budget and Mission Support

Thank you for your generous, continued support of the local church budget. Through this collection, we are able to continue our ministry here in Iron Springs. We also have an opportunity today to support our many missionaries who are bringing the glorious gospel of Christ to the world.

### May 12 - Prolife

Today, we have the opportunity to stand for life. The funds collected today will go to support the work of the Lethbridge and District Prolife. Their mission is "to proclaim the inherent value of human life from conception to natural death." Some of the things they do include, working with the Knights of Columbus to provide a place of mourning for the preborn at the cemeteries in Lethbridge. They provide multiple scholarships to students going on to post-secondary education, and cover the registration costs of post-secondary students who need to access daycares. They provide schools and homeschooled families with education resources. They also support agencies who care for mothers and babies in need.

### May 19 - Resonate Global Missions

Resonate Global Missions was formed in 2017, as Christian Reformed World Missions and Christian Reformed Home Missions united to become one organization. Resonate works alongside congregations, preparing missionaries and volunteers, calling and supporting church planters and campus ministers, connecting with ministries overseas, engaging church members and younger generations in mission work, and following the Spirit by discerning new ways to demonstrate and proclaim the gospel.

#### May 26 - Reframe Ministries

Reframe ministries is celebrating their 80<sup>th</sup> anniversary this year. We give thanks to God for this ministry's longevity. "Our vision is that the lives and worldviews of all people around the globe will be transformed by God's gospel message. Relying on the guidance of the Holy Spirit, we create contextual media resources that proclaim the gospel, disciple believers, and strengthen the church throughout the world in 10 major languages."
